



# Education Application Notes

REACT is the flexible tool for communication in K-12 and Higher Education environments. With communication to Public Information Screens, Computer Desktops, Cell Phones, Telephones and Email, REACT improves processes in many vital areas. The following are areas where REACT Education users have seen significant improvement in operations.



## Emergency Communication

REACT provides instant notification with information specific to the situation and recipient to ensure that proper procedures are followed and that needed information is at the fingertips of staff, students, and responders. REACT users have seen a significant improvement in the ability to communicate proper procedures for dealing with lockdowns, weather events, and medical situations. REACT communicates quickly, often eliminating minutes from the time it takes to initiate and communicate information about an event.

## General Information Presentation

REACT is used for communicating information even when there are not emergency situations occurring. Some examples of the way REACT is used include: Welcome and registration information, cafeteria menus, staff report deadlines, classroom changes and sports event information.

## Communication to Parents, Students, Mobile Staff, and Community

REACT presents the appropriate information to people who may be affected by an incident quickly and easily. It also allows for communication in plain language as suggested by the NIMS (National Incident Management System) developed by the Department of Homeland Security. More than just telling people that something is wrong, REACT provides specific instructions on how to remain safe or effectively respond to a situation, as appropriate to the person. REACT communicates in any language, ensuring that people can quickly understand the instructions presented to them.

## Flexible Initiation Options

REACT provides the ability to initiate and manage events from any location. Already this has proven an important capability for REACT users as those responsible for managing events cannot always be present to properly manage the situation. REACT frees those users to manage from anywhere. Also available is the ability to create panic buttons for staff, teachers, and appropriate individuals, providing the capability of pressing a button to launch instant requests for security or medical assistance.
